## **Middle States:**

Middle States is an accreditation process schools go through all over the world. It is a self-study that enhances improvement and is reviewed by a visiting panel of educators as well as a team at Middle States headquarters. It is a plan that is reviewed at least bi-annually to determine if progress is being made towards goals established by committees. With your input from our surveys, parent meetings and committees working on the standards (there are 12), the school community has established the following objectives within the Action Plan:

<u>Objective 1</u>: By the year 2020, SI students will demonstrate higher levels of understanding in ELA by an increase of 5% in scores on standardized testing. Actions: ELA curriculum committee, adopt methods of assessment using technology, review methods/strategies supporting student reading, update and supplement learning materials.

<u>Objective 2</u>: By the year 2020, SI students will demonstrate higher levels of understanding in math and science by an increase of 5% in scores on standardized testing. Actions: establish math and science committees, evaluate and update science curriculum and resources, form colloquium to evaluate and implement STREAM across curriculum.

## STREAM=SCIENCE-TECHNOLOGY-RELIGION-ENGINEERING-ART-MATH

<u>Objective 3</u>: Increase student opportunities to participate in faith-based activities. Actions: increase presence of clergy/religious in school, provide additional support for students to participate in local and global service activities.

<u>Objective 4</u>: Maintain current enrollment in a declining market utilizing strategic marketing strategies. Actions: update school website, increase school name visibility in community, re-establish marketing committee, develop relationships with marketing professionals.
