Nockamixon Park News:

Our free pontoon boat tours are once again back. They will be held most Tuesday and Wednesday evenings starting May 19 and ending September 2. Tours in May, June, and July will go from 6-8 pm and tours in August and September will be from 5-7 pm. As in past years, we are setting a limit of ONE tour per person. These are very popular and we get a long waiting list. Tours may be cancelled due to low temperatures, rain, thunderstorms, or strong winds. Children under 3 years of age must provide their own PFDs (life jackets). Please arrive 15 minutes early for your tour. We will be meeting at the Marina Building.

To register, you MUST call the Park Office at 215-529-7300 and choose Option 6. Online registration is not yet available for the new calendar of events. "Following" an event on the calendar of events is not the same as registering. Email registrations will not be accepted. Please do not call the Education Center to register as I am rarely at my desk. Please have patience as we have only one person answering the phones. When you call you will be asked to provide an email for confirmations.

If you find that you can't attend a tour after you register, please call the Park Office as soon as possible so we open the spots up to our waiting list. The tours are free, but donations to the Friends of Nockamixon State Park are always welcomed.
