Welcome to 1st grade!

I am so excited to be your teacher and help you grow. In this packet you will find things to help you prepare for 1st grade.

Reading: Read as often as you can, as much as you can, and anything you can. Read with someone, to someone, or by yourself.

Read for 20 minutes each day and complete the attached reading log for June, July, and August.

<u>Math</u>: Practice counting forward and backwards, as well as by 10's. <u>Complete addition and subtraction sheets</u>. Use manipulatives like legos, snap cubes, seashells, or goldfish to help you. My favorite math app is Moose Math.

Writing: Please have your child <u>complete at least 2 journal entries</u>. You may copy and they may do more if they'd like. Students should first draw a picture in the box, they can draw anything they want. After they finish creating their picture they can then write about their picture. Please DO NOT help them with spelling as they are writing. I want them to practice invented spelling or spelling words based on letter sounds and phonics rules they've previously learned. When doing this, there is not a "wrong" or a "right" way. Encourage them, say the words they are trying to spell to them slowly and with annunciation. You will be amazed!

<u>Sight words</u>: A list of kindergarten and 1st grade high frequency words are included. Kindergarten words should be mastered, please continue to review them. 1st grade words are included so that your child can begin familiarizing themself.

<u>Transportation</u>: Please email me with your child's arriving and departing transportation once it is known. Please include bus numbers and district.


All summer work is due the first day of school. I will be checking my email periodically throughout the summer, please feel free to email with any questions or concerns. There are no silly questions, I am here to help!


